Money Quiz Questions

- We have two types of physical money (that we can touch and hold) they are called coins and notes. Paper money, or notes comes in 'POUNDS'. What do we call coins?
- How many pence are in one pound?
- Can you draw the symbol we use for pounds?
- Whose face do we see on one side of our coins? Whose face is that going to change to?
- One side of our coins we call heads, what do we call the other side?
- How do you know how much a coin is worth?
- How many different coins do we use?
- How many different notes do we use?
- How many copper-coloured coins do we have?
- Which coins are silver coloured?
- Which coins have gold-coloured edges?
- How many 2p coins do you need to make 10p?
- How many 10p coins do you need to make £2?
- If I have three coins that total 26p, what coins do I have?
- If I buy something that costs 20p and I pay with a 50p coin. How much change will I get?
